



The poem was widely published in newspapers, magazines, and picture books, and that version of the story quickly spread around the world. Santa's red suit and hat are said to symbolize his efforts to bring happiness to people.

All around the world there are tales of a Santa Claus figure, sometimes in the form of a witch or a king. In all these stories, Santa makes children happy by bringing them presents.










